

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-07

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DONNA ADOPTING THE INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE, 2015 EDITION WITH APPENDICES A – M, AND WITH AN ADDENDUM: REPEALING ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DONNA, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1: Fire Code Adopted

The International Fire Code, 2015 Edition with appendices A – M, promulgated by the International Code Council, Inc., and shall be known as The City of Donna Fire Code.

Section 2: Addendum

2015 Fire Code, Section 102.8 matters not provided for. Requirements that are essential for the public safety of an existing or proposed activity, building or structure, or for the safety of occupants thereof, which are not specifically provided for by this code shall be determined by the Fire Code Official and the City Manager.

Section 3: Conflicting Ordinances Repealed

All ordinances, orders or resolutions or parts thereof, heretofore passed and adopted by the City of Donna in conflict herewith shall be, and the same are, hereby repealed.

Section 4: Severability Clause

If any portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or inoperative, the remaining portions hereof shall not be affected but remain in full force and effect.

Section 5: Penalty Clause

Anyone who violates this article shall upon conviction thereof be fined in any amount not less than \$50.00 or more than \$200.00. Each day that the violation continues to exist is a separate offense.


Section 6: Publication And Effective Date

Passed and Approved upon first reading on this 3rd day of **February 2015**.




